TAP is mandatory for all separating/retiring Service members on Title 10 orders for 180 or more consecutive days. Service members may start TAP not earlier than 12 months before separation or 24 months before retirement, and should complete all parts of TAP not later than 90 days prior to separation or retirement. Preseparation Counseling is available as a group briefing or individually by appointment. Spouses are welcome and encouraged to attend. Preseparation Counseling must be completed before attending the Transition GPS Workshop</p>
