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<p>Separatee Group Preseparation Briefing 2, 16 & 30 August 2018, 0800-1130 (Room 120) Retiree Group Preseparation Briefing 14 & 28 August 2018, 0800-1130 (Room 120)</p>	<p>Step 1 of TAP is Preseparation Counseling which is available as a group briefing or individually by appointment. The purpose is to ensure Service members are informed of the services and benefits available to assist them and their families with the transition to civilian life. TAP is mandatory for all separating/retiring Service members on Title 10 orders (active duty) for 180 continuous days or more. Service members may start TAP not earlier than 24 months before retirement or 12 months before separation, and should complete all parts of TAP not later than 90 days prior to separation or retirement. <i>Preseparation Counseling must be completed before attending the Transition GPS Workshop.</i> Spouses are welcome and encouraged to attend.</p>
