Pre-Teens

Parent's Night Out: For youth ages 5-12 on select Fridays from 6:30pm-10:30pm. Member cost is \$10.00 and non-member cost is \$15.00 and includes dinner.

Torch Club: This is a youth leadership development club for pre-teens. Members plan their own activities, service events, and monthly community service projects.
